

Senior Ballet Assessments 2020

Introduction

Dance assessments are an important part of the teaching and learning programmes at Kew School of Dance. Assessments are a natural extension of the work covered in class each week and an important component of concert preparation.

Dance exams are part of the tradition of dance training and provide a goal for students to work towards. They help students maintain steady progress and provide valuable external feedback to both students and teachers.

We recommend that you take the opportunity to enter for this assessment. Once you have chosen to enter, you must maintain regular attendance at all classes between now and the exam. Remember that as well as gaining proficiency in your own dancing, you must work together with the other dancers in your exam group. It's not fair on the other dancers if you're missing; you all need to practise together.

If you do not feel you can meet the required level of commitment for participation in the preparation process as well as the assessment performance, then we suggest you do not enter for assessment. If you would like to discuss any aspect of this further, please contact Miss Alice.
